19:1-15

- Pride of Egypt #1 – The Spirit World 1-4
 - Pick a “god,” any “god.”
 - Religious turmoil leads to political unrest!
 - Seeking answers in all the wrong places.
 - Be careful what you ask for!
- Pride of Egypt #2 - Economic Superpower – The Nile! 5-10
 - State of Emergency: The mighty Nile evaporates!
 - No more Egyptian cotton! – The economy evaporates!
- Pride of Egypt #3 - Wisdom of Egypt
 - The best and brightest are dunces in the corner!
 - Walking in circles!

The shocking deliverance of Egypt!

19:16-25

- Role Reversal: Egypt & Judah! 16-17
 - The strong will become weak; the weak will become strong!
- A total change of lips and heart. 18
 - One language – To read the Holy Word of God!
 - One LORD – They will swear allegiance to the LORD!
- Egypt Redeemed 19-22
 - From the heartland to the border!
 - A new relationship!
 - They will experience divine deliverance (Savior).
- We are family! 23-25
 - The highway of the LORD (See 11:16)!
