

Song of the Servant. pt. 2
Isaiah 52:13-53:12
August 4, 2024

- **The Servant's Future Exaltation** **52:13-15**
 - He will be raised, lifted up, and highly exalted – v. 13
 - Completely shattered – v. 14
 - He will cause the kings to shut their mouths – v. 15
- **The Servant Rejected (Birth & Life)** **53:1-3**
 - Who could have seen this? – v. 1
 - Note: He is the “Arm of the LORD!” (See Isaiah 52:10)
 - Remarkably unremarkable – v. 2
 - Despised and rejected – v. 3
- **The Servant Afflicted** **53:4-6**
 - Took up our infirmities/ sorrows – v. 4
 - See also Matthew 8:17 (cf. Rev. 21:4!)
 - Pierced for our transgressions – v. 5
 - See the Cross – John 19:34! (cf. John 20:25-27)
 - We have gone astray, He bore our iniquity – v. 6
 - See Leviticus 16:22 – the Scapegoat
- **The Servant Sacrificed (Trial & Death)** **53:7-9**
 - Oppressed & Afflicted, but silent – v. 7
 - Did not open his mouth – See Matthew 26:63; 27:12 & 14; John 19:8-9!
 - Oppressed & cut off for our transgressions – v.8
 - Sent to the grave, for no fault of his own – v.9
- **The Servant Exalted** **53:10-12**
 - God approved sin offering – v. 10 (compare to Lev. 5:1-6:7.)
 - Resurrected & justifies many – v. 11
 - Bore the sin of many – v. 12

Key:

- God's plan for the salvation of the world is revealed 700 years before it happened!

Application:

- Will you believe the message? (See Isaiah 53:1!)
