John 1:14-18

- The Word became flesh...
 - Was vs. Became = Compare John 1:1-2 & 1:14
 - Was (Eternally pre-existent)
 - Became (Change in Time).
 - o Total Humanness
 - John 4:6 ...tired as he was from the journey...
 - John 4:31 ... "Rabbi, eat something."
 - Mark 5:38 Jesus was in the stern, sleeping on a cushion...
- ...and made his dwelling among us.
 - Tabernacled/ Tented Place of Dwelling (See Revelation 21:3)
- We have seen his glory...
 - The <u>**Sh</u>ekin</u>ah Glory of God (See Exodus 40:34-35)</u>**
 - o "Tented" (Greek = <u>SK</u>E<u>N</u>OW)
 - Tabernacle/ Glory The place of the presence of God!
- Full of grace & truth Only found in John 1:14 & 1:17.
 - Compare w/ OT "kindness and faithfulness." See Exodus 34:6-7
- Other Passages
 - o Galatians 4:4 Born of a Woman
 - Luke 2:4-7;12 The Birth of Jesus!
 - Philippians 2:6-8a...Being found in appearance as a man.

Keys: Two "Ancient" Heresies

- Jesus was not human at all. (see 1 John 4:1-3)
- Jesus was only a man. (See Colossians 1:19; 2:9)

Application:

- Humanity: If Jesus isn't fully human, He could not save us! (Hebrews 2:14)
- Deity: If Jesus isn't fully God, He could not pay for the sins of the whole world! (1 John 2:2)
