Psalm 1

- The Path of the Righteous 1-3
 - Don't do this!
 - Walk/ Stand/ Sit – The whole manner of life!
 - (See Proverbs 2:12-15!)
 - Do this!
 - Delight in the Law of the LORD!
 - Meditate. (See Joshua 1:8!)
 - Meditate: Mutter, talk to yourself = verbal processing
 - The final result: Abundant Blessing
 - Vibrant (See Jeremiah 17:7-8!)
 - Fruitful (See John 15!)
 - Enduring
 - Prosperous... Thriving! (See Philippians 4:11-12!)
- The Path of the Wicked 4-5
 - Wicked = those who are hostile to God.
 - Worthless = Chaff
 - Useless = Wind blows away.
 - The final result – No place in the people of God!
- Key: The two paths summarized: 6
 - The LORD watches over the path of the righteous.
 - But the path of the wicked will perish.

Application:

- What path are you walking?
 - Where are you spending all of your time?
 - Are you rooted in the Lord? (See Colossians 2:6-7)
- What does your heart delight in?
 - The things of God – His Word?
 - The things of the world?
